What is lactoferrin?


Lactoferrin is a protein biomarker that is present during an inflammatory response. Studies have shown that fecal lactoferrin is elevated in patients suffering from inflammatory diarrhea and active Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD).

Lactoferrin testing is a valuable tool in diagnosing and monitoring patients with IBD

- Lactoferrin diagnostics by TECHLAB are the first US FDA-cleared tests to detect intestinal inflammation in IBD patients with active flares
- Measuring lactoferrin levels in patients diagnosed with IBD can help indicate the degree of IBD severity
